



## **Hui Li, 回礼 (*All dialects*)**

- Gifts for the groom (watch, belt or a wallet with an ang bao inserted)
- 2 bottles of orange juice or syrup
- A portion of the Guo Da Li gifts from groom (Usually half will be returned)
- Huat kueh or Fatt Koh (发糕)
- Sugar Cane (Hokkien)
- 1 Ruler
- A red umbrella
- Pants or suit (Cantonese only; Homophone for 福 in Cantonese)
- Dowry from Bride's family ( For the groom to bring back to the bridal room)
  - Furniture such as bed, mattress or dressing table
  - 1 set of sewing kit (To be bound together)
  - 5-piece descendent pail set (Baby bathtub, wash basin, mug, tray, potty)
  - 1 Tea set (For the tea ceremony at the groom's side)
  - A set of bedsheet and duvet for the bridal bed
  - A dining set consisting of a pair of chopsticks, spoons, bowls and plates
  - A pair of bedside Lamp
  - Fate coins (大缘小缘)
- Clothing and accessories for the Bride
  - Bag/ Purse with angbao inserted
  - New clothes stuffed with longan
  - New shoes for the bride
